

Chemical Safety Checklist

<input type="checkbox"/>	Chemical Storage Safety
<input type="checkbox"/>	Chemicals stored in approved, labeled containers.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Flammables stored in fire-rated cabinets.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Incompatible chemicals properly separated.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Storage areas free of spills, leaks, or corrosion.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Containers kept closed when not in use.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Chemical inventory list kept up to date.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Labeling Requirements
<input type="checkbox"/>	All containers labeled per GHS standards.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Secondary containers labeled before use.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Labels include pictograms, signal words, and hazard statements.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Damaged or missing labels replaced immediately.
<input type="checkbox"/>	No unlabeled chemicals anywhere in facility.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Chemical Handling Procedures
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proper PPE worn (gloves, goggles, respirators, etc.).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Employees trained before using hazardous chemicals.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proper ventilation used when handling volatile chemicals.
<input type="checkbox"/>	No eating, drinking, or smoking near chemicals.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Chemical transfer performed with proper tools and funnels.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Emergency Equipment
<input type="checkbox"/>	Eyewash stations accessible and tested weekly.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Safety showers operational and inspected.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spill kits stocked and located nearby.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fire extinguishers accessible and inspected.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Emergency contact numbers posted and visible.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spill Response
<input type="checkbox"/>	Employees trained in spill response procedures.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spill area evacuated and contained quickly.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Correct absorbents used for type of chemical.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Contaminated waste disposed properly.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spill report completed after cleanup.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Waste Management

■	Waste stored in designated area only.
■	No mixing incompatible waste types.
■	Waste removal scheduled and documented.
