

PPE Compliance Checklist

<input type="checkbox"/>	Head & Face Protection
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hard hats worn in required areas.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hard hats inspected for cracks, dents, or wear.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Face shields available and used when needed.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Safety glasses worn in all mandatory zones.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Prescription eyewear has approved protective coverage.
<input type="checkbox"/>	No missing or damaged components on head/face PPE.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hand Protection
<input type="checkbox"/>	Gloves appropriate for task (cut-resistant, chemical, heat, etc.).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Gloves inspected for holes, tears, or excessive wear.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Chemical-resistant gloves used where required.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Impact gloves available for heavy or sharp material handling.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Gloves replaced when damaged or contaminated.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Foot Protection
<input type="checkbox"/>	Steel-toe or composite safety footwear worn in designated areas.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Slip-resistant soles in good condition.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Footwear free of excessive wear, cracks, or separation.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Metatarsal guards used when required.
<input type="checkbox"/>	No open-toe or soft footwear in production areas.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hearing Protection
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hearing protection worn in high-noise areas.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Earplugs or earmuffs available and stored properly.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Employees trained on proper use and fit.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hearing conservation areas clearly marked.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hearing protection replaced when worn or damaged.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Respiratory Protection
<input type="checkbox"/>	Respirators issued where required by job task.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fit testing completed and documented.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Cartridges and filters replaced per schedule.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Dust masks worn in dusty environments.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Respirators stored in clean, dry locations.

■	High-visibility clothing worn in traffic or forklift areas.
■	Aprons, jackets, or protective sleeves used as required.
■	Clothing free of loose threads, rips, or hazards.
■	Chemical-resistant clothing available when needed.
■	Heat-resistant clothing used for high-temperature processes.
■	General PPE Compliance
■	Employees trained on PPE requirements.
■	PPE signage posted and visible.
■	Damaged PPE reported immediately.
■	PPE stored in designated areas.
■	Supervisors enforce PPE usage consistently.
■	PPE inspections completed regularly.



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
